Whangaparaoa College is a co-educational school which is located to the North of Auckland. Whangaparaoa is Maori for "Bay of Whales". Pods of orca and dolphins can be regularly spotted in the peninsula waters. Whangaparaoa is a safe area surrounded by many beaches, parks, and reserves. It takes about 30 minutes by the motorway to get to the centre of Auckland City.

At Whangaparaoa College students will learn in one of the most modern schools in New Zealand. The school opened in 2005 on an environmentally aware site.
