#### TRANSITION YEAR

In addition to core subjects and a language option, students study Architectural drawing, Technical Drawing, Home Economics, Engineering, PE, Home Economics, Environmental and Social Studies, Science, Chinese, Media Studies, Cookery, Computer studies, Creative writing, Business studies, Career guidance.

Work experience takes place every Friday. One placement must be organised every term.
